SATURVIIT INUIT WOMEN ASSOCIATION OF NUNAVIK

BACKGROUND

During the summer of 2005, Inuit women came from each of the Nunavik's 14 communities and from the South to meet at Qilalugaq camp near Puvirnitug. They discussed issues they felt were important to their communities: parenting, child abuse, suicide, education, language, healing and violence. They recommended the creation of a women's association to strengthen the voices of Nunavik women.

Saturviit is a non-profit organization open to all women 16 years old and over who are JBNQA beneficiaries. Associate Membership is available for non-beneficiaries, businesses and organizations, Membership is free

MISSION

To represent Nunavik women and their children and advocate for their well-being and interests.

Our **Vision** is to guide women to take actions to strengthen the voice and to prosper in all aspects of life; we advocate for programs and services that promote and support healthy women and families.

OBJECTIVES

1. to advocate for women and children in Nunavik
2. to develop activities to counter violence against women and children and improve their well-being
3. to provide tools to help the women to fulfill themselves in the political, economic or in their social life
4. to support community projects that benefit women
5. to represent Inuit women of Nunavik in the national, provincial and regional meetings.

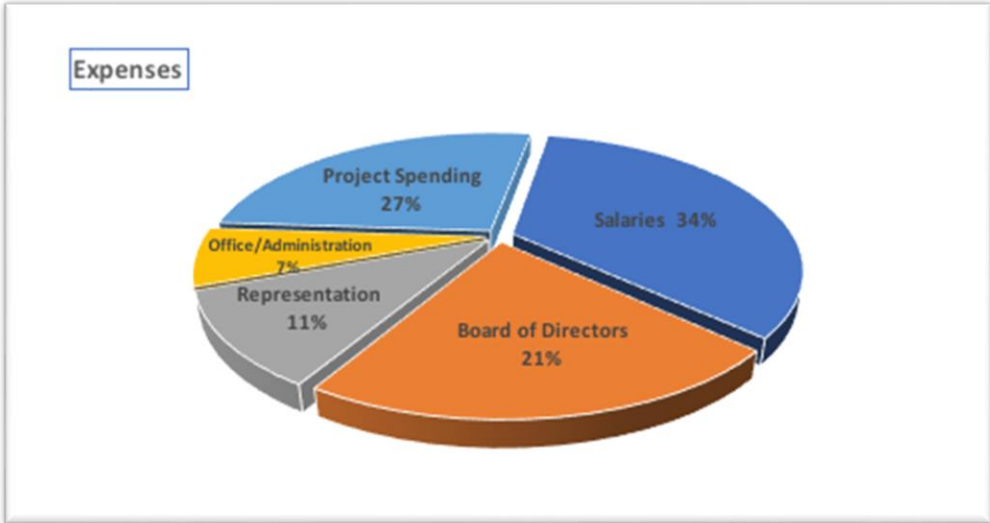
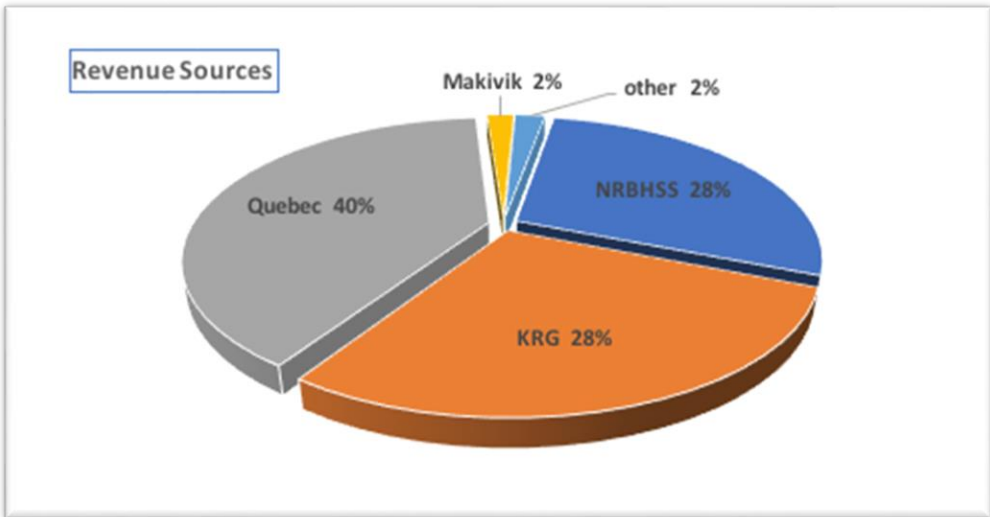
